### **ACTION REQUIRED**

Approve the EA/RIR/IRFA document for public review.

#### **BACKGROUND**

At its April meeting, the Council requested further analysis of the herring bycatch management chapter from the Amendment 21/16 package. In addition, the Council tasked the BSAI plan team to prepare additional halibut and crab bycatch management measures. These measures include inseason authority for the Regional Director to close bycatch hot-spots and provision for the Council to allocate a portion of the pollock TAC to midwater trawl gear. Together, these analyses constitute Amendment 16a to the BSAI groundfish FMP. An outline of Amendment 16a is provided as item D-3(c)(1). A copy of the amendment document was mailed to you last week.

If approved for public review, they would be available for comment over the summer months and final Council action would be scheduled for the September meeting. Any measures adopted would likely be implemented in March or April, 1991.
