Ecosystem Committee

The Council's Ecosystem Committee met on November 12 to review updates on the BS FEP LKTKS Taskforce and an EFH consultation on a mining project in Norton Sounds, and to discuss the possibility

of another Council Ecosystem Workshop and other Ecosystem Committee initiatives. The report is posted under this agenda item, and staff coordinator Steve MacLean is available to present the report if desired.

Tasking and Scheduling

Posted on the eAgenda are updated versions of tasking documents that are normally included as background material for staff tasking: the 3-meeting outlook, Council staff responsibilities, groundfish workplan update, and status of Observer Program projects.

We have also provided an update on the status of all ongoing or initiated Council projects scheduled for 2021 and beyond, and advisory groups, in Tables 1 and 2.

We continue to plan for online meetings through the winter and spring of 2021, although we will continue to monitor prevailing conditions to determine when we can meet in person again.

Draft February 2021 agenda

A preliminary February 2021 agenda is posted to the eAgenda for your review. Similar to December, we are planning 7 hour meeting days and not meeting over the weekend. This schedule is designed to overlap the SSC and AP meetings as in December, to shorten the overall meeting footprint. The agenda item that must be taken up in February is the BSAI crab specifications for Norton Sound red king crab.
