




2018-2021 BSAI Total Catch




2021 BSAI Total Groundfish Catch by Gear & Sector




2021 A Season Bering Sea Pollock Directed Fishery (CV)




2021 A Season Bering Sea Pollock Directed Fishery (CP)




2021 Bering Sea Pollock Catch by Week and Sector




2021 Aleutian Islands Pollock Catch by Week and Sector


2021 Bering Sea Pollock ICA Catch by Week and Sector




2017-2021 Trawl Catcher/Processor Incidental Catch of Pollock by Year and Target




2021 Pacific Cod Catch by Trawl Gear














2021 Atka Mackerel Catch by Week and Area

2017-2021 Northern Rockfish Catch by Area















2021 Flatfish Catch




2021 BSAI Flatfish Catch by Amendment 80 Catcher/Processors



2021 BSAI Flatfish Catch by Non-Amendment 80 Vessels




2017-2021 BSAI Trawl Flatfish Catch by Species









2021 BSAI Hook-and-Line Not Including Pacific Cod Catch




2021 BSAI Sablefish Catch





2021 Zone 1 Trawl Red King Crab Incidental Catch by Target






2017-2021 Fixed Gear Red King Crab Incidental Catch





2021 COBLZ Trawl Opilio Crab Incidental Catch by Target




2021 PSC Rate of Opilio Crab








2021 Zone 2 Trawl Bairdi Crab Incidental Catch by Target


2021 Non-Pollock Fishery Chinook Salmon Incidental Catch by Fishery and Sector





2021 BSAI Trawl Non-Chinook Salmon Incidental Catch




2021 PSC Count of Non-Chinook Salmon








2021 BSAI Pollock Fishery Non-Chinook Salmon Incidental Catch
