



## I. High Seas Drift Net Enforcement

On May 30, a Canadian CP-140 patrol aircraft detected a HSDN profile vessel in position 33N, 158E. Vessel did not display name, radio call sign or flag. Subsequent flights were unable to relocate the vessel. No additional suspicious activity has been detected for the reporting period. CG C-130's conducted 8 sorties for a total of 64.5 hours during the reporting period.

## II. US/Russian Maritime Boundary Line (MBL) Enforcement

Figures 2-7 provide plots of foreign fishing vessel activity along the MBL, along with information regarding sightings and incursions. For the reporting period, the following details apply:

- Coast Guard C130's flew 44 sorties totaling 313 hours
- Coast Guard HEC/MECs spent 76 days patrolling the line
- 20 vessels were visually confirmed, and one radar contact was suspected to be fishing in US waters. The Coast Guard boarded six of these vessels
- 4 vessels were seized
- 2 vessels were given a verbal warning
- 8 eight case packages were referred to RS FBS
- 8 vessels were not pursued due to lack of ships or weather

On July 31, CGC ACUSHNET detected FF/V SPITAK (RS) fishing 800 yards inside the US EEZ. Although the vessel hauled back in RS waters, it complied with CG orders to return to US EEZ for boarding. SPITAK was seized, taken to Dutch Harbor and subsequently released after paying \$186K in fines and custody costs. Vessel had 150 lbs. of pollock on board.


On August 13, a CG C-130 detected five FF/V's actively fishing inside the US EEZ. Because of the depth of its incursion, 1200 yards, FF/V MING CHANG (PRC) was pursued and refused to stop. Hot pursuit was handed to CGC HAMILTON. It subsequently stopped for Russian patrol vessel ARGAL; a joint boarding was conducted with CGC HAMILTON. After assessing an \$15K fine RS authorities released the vessel to the CG. Vessel was seized, taken to Dutch Harbor, and released after posting a \$1.5M bond. The US Attorney General Office is proceeding with a forfeiture action.

On September 5, CGC ALEX HALEY detected by radar the FF/V KUM KANG SAN (KS) 1000 yards inside of the US EEZ. Shortly thereafter, KUM KANG SAN was visually observed with its nets deployed. After a second radio attempt, the vessel hauled its nets. KUM KANG SAN was seized, taken to Dutch Harbor where a case package was submitted to NMFS. The vessel settled for \$300K.

On September 23, a CG C-130 detected FF/V ORCHID (KS) actively fishing 600 yards inside the US EEZ. Hot pursuit was handed to CGC JARVIS. CG subsequently conducted a joint boarding with FBS vsl ASKOLD PYNKO, which had imposed a \$18K fine on the vessel for its incursion into RS Forbidden Zone. CG then seized ORCHID and took vessel to Dutch Harbor. Case pends.

Figures 2-5 provide plots of peak days of activity on MBL per month by C-130's.

Figure 2. 23 JUN 00 M/B Scatter Plot of Aircraft Sightings






Figure 4. 16 AUG 00 M/B Scatter Plot of Aircraft Sightings






Figure 3. 10 JULY 00 M/B Scatter Plot of Aircraft Sightings

**Figure 5. 18 Sep 00 MBL Scatterplot of Aircraft Sightings**




**Figure 6. 1997-2000 MBL Incursions into U.S. EEZ**

### III. Donut Hole

Three foreign vessels conducted trial fishing in the Donut Hole during the period, one vessel from Poland and two vessels from the Republic of China. Coast Guard did not board these vessels nor did we receive any information regarding fishing results. There are no vessels scheduled to conduct trial fishing for the remainder of the year.

### IV. Dixon Entrance Enforcement

Coast Guard enforcement efforts consisted of 94 patrol boat days and 18 HH-60J sorties from Air Station Sitka totaling 80 hours. A Canadian charter vessel operating in US waters without proper ADF&G documentation was referred to the State of Alaska.

### V. IFQ At-Sea/Dockside Enforcement

There were no significant violations detected during the reporting period. 73 cutter days and 65 helo sorties totaling 251.6 hours from Kodiak and Sitka were flown in support of IFQ for the reporting period. Coast Guard effort consisted of the following:


- 56 IFQ at sea boardings

Figure 8. Historical Overview of CFVS Statistics




## VII. CGD17 Boarding Statistics

## VIII. Steller Sea Lions and Critical Habitat Enforcement

The Coast Guard has issued an additional Operational Order in response to the ban on trawling in the Steller Sea Lion Critical Habitat. The order directs additional flights and cutter patrols through the affected areas. No incursions were reported.

**2000 MARITIME BOUNDARY ACTIVITY**

**27 Jun** CGC Alex Haley detected the FF/V KAPITAN DEMIDENKO(RS) 400 yards inside the US EEZ. A second incursion of 600 yards occurred in fog approximately 5 hrs later. Both times the CGC Alex Haley was unable to confirm that the nets were deployed. CGC Alex Haley advised FFV Kapitan Demidenko of intent to provide evidence of incursion to Russian authorities and prosecute pending reentry of vsl into US EEZ. Info passed to FBS.

**04 Jul** CGC ALEX HALEY detected the FF/V KAI FA(PRC) 800 yards inside the US EEZ. There was insufficient evidence available to support a seizure. D17 reviewed position information and determined there was too much uncertainty as to the magnitude of the depth of the incursion. Evidence passed to Russian Federal Boarder Guard for further prosecution. Info passed to FBS and PRC authorities.

**28 Jul** A C-130 patrol detected and videotaped FF/V AERONAVT(RS) 1000 yards inside the US EEZ. Fishing gear was observed on deck. AERONAVT did not respond to Ch 16 calls. C-130 subsequently detected the FF/V MING ZHU (PRC) fishing 200 yards inside of the EEZ. Vessel immediately returned to the RS EEZ. Cutter was not available to continue hot pursuit.

**31 Jul** CGC ACUSHNET detected the FF/V SPITAK (RS) fishing 800 yards inside the US EEZ and commenced hot pursuit. SPITAK complied with orders to stop, recovered nets within RS EEZ, but returned to US EEZ for boarding. There were no fish in the nets and 150 lbs of fish on board. CGC ACUSHNET seized the SPITAK and escorted her to Dutch Harbor. SPITAK settled for \$186K and was released

**02 Aug** A C-130 detected FF/V EKARMA-1 (RS) fishing 300 yards inside the US EEZ. The vessel did not respond to hails and returned to the RS EEZ. Advised vsl of intent to provide evidence of incursion to Russian authorities and prosecute pending reentry of vsl into US EEZ. Info passed to Russian FBS.

**12 Aug** Helo from CGC HAMILTON detected FF/V AERONAVT (RS) fishing about 100 yards inside of our EEZ. It quickly returned to the Russian EEZ prior to being able to establish hot pursuit. Later that day C-130 detected five FF/V's actively fishing inside the US EEZ. Deepest incursion was the FF/V MING CHANG (PRC) fishing 1200 yards inside US EEZ. C-130 initiated and maintained hot pursuit until relieved by CGC Hamilton. FF/V MING CHANG refused boarding. D17 coordinated joint boarding with FBS officials from the Russian patrol vessel ARGAL. FBS issued \$15K fine for violation of the 1.5 nm buffer zone and turned the vessel over to US for seizure. It was subsequently escorted to Dutch Harbor. FF/V MING CHANG posted a \$1.5 million dollar bond, case pends. There was 375 metric tons of processed pollock on board.

**18 Aug** CGC ALEX HALEY detected the FF/V RYUHO MARU 51(JA) fishing 700 yards inside the US EEZ. A boarding discovered outdated MBL coordinates. The vessel was issued a warning and released for insufficient evidence.

**24 Aug** CGC Alex Haley detected the FF/V EKARMA-3 (RS) fishing 1060 yards inside the US EEZ. Hot pursuit was terminated due to on scene weather conditions. . Advised vsl of intent to provide evidence of incursion to Russian authorities and prosecute pending reentry of vsl into US EEZ. Info passed to FBS.

**31 Aug** CGC Hamilton detected the FF/V EKARMA-1 (RS) fishing 300 yards inside the US EEZ. Low visibility and fleet density prevented ability to establish hot pursuit. Later, CGC HAMILTON detected the FF/V EKARMA-3 (RS) 500 yards inside the US EEZ. CGC HAMILTON was not able to establish hot pursuit prior to the vessel crossing back into the RS EEZ. Info passed to FBS.

**05 Sep** CGC Alex Haley detected the FF/V KUM KANG SAN (KS) fishing 1000 yards inside the US EEZ . The vessel was visually observed with nets in the water, but had no product on board. The vessel was seized and escorted to Dutch Harbor. The vessel settled for \$300K.

**12 Sep** A C-130 detected the FF/V AERONAVT (RS) fishing 200 yards inside the US EEZ. Attempts at hailing the AERONAVT on CH 16 were unsuccessful. The vessel returned to the RS EEZ; no cutter on scene to respond. Advised vsl of intent to provide evidence of incursion to Russian authorities and prosecute pending reentry of vsl into US EEZ. Info passed to FBS.

**14 Sep** A C-130 detected the FF/V KIROVO (RS) fishing 1400 yards inside of the US EEZ. Upon being sighted, vessel recovered nets and returned to RS EEZ. Advised vsl of intent to provide evidence of incursion to Russian authorities and prosecute pending reentry of vsl into US EEZ. Info passed to FBS.

**21 Sep** CGC JARVIS detected the FF/V GEMINI (RS) fishing 1000 yards inside the US EEZ. CGC JARVIS initiated hot pursuit and pursued vessel into RS EEZ. Vessel refused to stop. D17 coordinated with FBS vessel ASKOLD PYNKO to conduct joint boarding. FBS issued \$86K fine and removed vessel from MBL.

**23 Sep** A C-130 detected FF/V ORCHID (KS) fishing 600 yards inside the US EEZ. Hot pursuit was initiated and handed off to CGC JARVIS. ORCHID refused to stop. D17 coordinated with FBS vessel ASKOLD PYNKO to conduct joint boarding. FBS issued \$18K fine for violation of buffer zone and released to CG. CG seized the Orchid and escorted to Dutch Harbor. Case pends.

## ENFORCEMENT REPORT FOR THE PERIOD 6/1/2000 THROUGH 9/30/00

National Marine Fisheries Service  
Alaska Enforcement Division

During the reporting period, NMFS and the Coast Guard opened a total of 295 cases. NMFS initiated 290 of these investigations.

Further action was taken on 383 pending cases during the reporting period. Eighty-nine investigations were closed as unfounded, 31 investigations were closed due to lack of evidence, 20 investigations were closed due to lack of Enforcement resources, and 16 investigations were dismissed for other reasons. Eighteen cases were referred to other Regions or other agencies. Twenty-seven cases were handled with written warnings or Fix-it tickets. Sixty-six cases were handled with payment of summary settlement penalties totaling \$92,696. Twenty-one cases were settled through voluntary abandonment of forfeited proceeds or property valued at \$31,924. Thirty cases were referred to NOAA General Counsel. General Counsel issued NOVAs in 26 cases for a total of \$177,838 in penalties and also settled 39 cases for approximately \$156,922 in penalties and \$1,272 in forfeited proceeds.

### Foreign Fishing Vessel Cases

FF/V ARCTIC WIND, a Honduran registered, high seas driftnet vessel, was forfeited to the U.S. Government and is ready for sale. NOAA General Counsel is soliciting bids and will auction the vessel on October 16, 2000. Please see the attached 2 pages giving particulars of the vessel and auction process.

FF/V SPITAK, a Russian trawler which was seized for illegal fishing across the Maritime Boundary Line (MBL) paid a settlement of \$186,000 for the violation and was released on September 5, 2000.

FF/V MING CHANG, a Republic of China stern trawl vessel was seized for a violation of the MBL and posted a bond of \$1.5 million and was released on September 30, 2000. Further investigation revealed an additional incursion may have occurred in July of this year. The U.S. Attorney's Office is preparing to go to trial on this case. Settlement of the case is still possible with attorneys for the vessel working with the United States Attorney's Office.



FF/V KUM KANG SAN, a Korean stern trawl vessel paid a settlement of \$300,000 for a MBL violation and was released on September 29, 2000.

FF/V ORCHID, a Korean stern trawl vessel, is in custody in Dutch Harbor for a violation of the MBL. The owner's have hired an attorney and are in contact with the U.S. Attorney's Office to discuss bond and/or settlement.

### Stellar Sea lions

Critical Habitat violations. We are investigating incursions into Critical Habitat areas which were closed as a result of an injunction by U.S. District Court Judge Thomas Zilly. At this time, there are 27 vessels under investigation. This includes catcher vessels as well as catcher/processors.

Individuals are being investigated for criminal violations of shooting at Stellar sea lions in the Gulf of Alaska. Witnesses have provided information indicating these fishermen have shoot and killed upwards of 20 animals in the past two years. In addition, numerous affidavits have been written by NMFS Certified Observers alleging various violations of the Magnuson-Stevens Act (observer harassment, intimidation, pre-sorting PSC, sample bias, etc)

An investigation continues into a captain of a vessel shooting numerous sea lions in 1999 and 2000. This violation occurred in the Gulf of Alaska and involves a salmon fishing vessel.

Ralph Boyington was convicted of taking stellar sea lions. His penalty was \$3,000, 6 months home confinement, and 2 years probation.

### Observer Case Investigations

An observer contractor is being investigated for misconduct. They failed to inform NMFS of harassment of their observers. The fish plant where this occurred is being investigated for the harassment.

An investigation is being conducted against a vessel crew member for physically assaulting an observer.

An investigation continues concerning a vessel, over the course of a year and a half, being involved in large scale sample biasing.

There are 25 observer related cases opened, and 150 affidavits alleging more violations are being reviewed.

### Beluga Watch 2000

The Alaska Enforcement Division tasked agents and officers to conduct patrols and community outreach to protect the Cook Inlet Belugas. AED had 11TDY's, each being two to three week tours. There were six investigations initiated. Of those six, 2 were closed for lack of evidence, 4 are still opened.

### **IFQ Program**

An investigation continues concerning a person making false statements to gain "IFQ crew member" status to allow them to purchase quota.

An investigation was initiated concerning under-reporting of IFQ fish landed in the U.S. and being transported to another country.

Kenai Custom Seafoods, its owner James Hill, Sr and his son James Hill, Jr, were indicted by a federal grand jury on one count of conspiracy and four counts of purchasing illegally harvested halibut in violation of the Lacey Act.

The F/V NINE was forfeited as the result of its owner, Lloyd Collins, being convicted of violations of the Lacey Act. The vessel was sold at auction for \$6,010.

### **Record keeping and Reporting Violations**

A shoreside plant is under investigation for under-reporting by-catch overages.

Depositions are planned for a case involving U.S. fishing vessels illegally transshipping product to foreign vessels. If no settlement is reached, then it will go to trial.

### **Community Oriented Policing and Problem Solving (COPPS)**

AED is preparing for a booth at Fish Expo in Seattle. We encourage industry members as well as the general public to stop by and meet with our staff there. We would like to hear your thoughts and answer your questions.
