

Activity within 20NM of US/RS MBL:

• 1 daily average



Suspected Transshipment Activity:

- On 14 January, 2018 RS notified D17 of 1 vessel (M/V SEA BREEZE, Sierra Leone flagged) suspected of fishing illegally for crab in US/RS EEZs
- HC130 located vessel in Donut Hole & attempted communication; no response
- Passed information to RS who deployed afloat assets
- Kamchatka Border Guard (KBG) boarded vessel in RS EEZ, issued 2 violations:
 - Not authorized to fish in RS EEZ
 - No logbook onboard
 - Fines exceeded \$114K
- KBG escorted vessel back to RS for further investigation






Fishing Vessel Boardings & Fisheries Violations

Vessels With Violations





