NOAA Fisheries invites **Alaska Federally-recognized Tribes, Alaska Native Corporations, and Tribal Organizations that represent Tribal Governments*** to engage with us on upcoming February Council meeting actions.

At the upcoming Council meeting, the Council will review:

- 1) the preliminary Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) on the management of chum salmon bycatch in the Bering Sea pollock fishery; and
- 2) the proposed 2025 harvest specifications for the federal salmon fishery in the Cook Inlet Exclusive Economic Zone.

This is an opportunity to ask questions of NMFS and Council staff about the contents of both documents, opportunities for participation at the Council meeting, or anything else related to the agenda items.
